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Full Report on Manufacturers' Shipments, Inventories and Orders October 2014

Summary

New orders for manufactured goods in October, down three consecutive months, decreased \$3.3 billion or 0.7 percent to \$496.6 billion, the U.S. Census Bureau reported today. This followed a 0.5 percent September decrease. Excluding transportation, new orders decreased 1.4 percent.

Shipments, down two of the last three months, decreased \$3.8 billion or 0.8 percent to \$499.2 billion. This followed a 0.1 percent September increase.

Unfilled orders, up eighteen of the last nineteen months, increased \$4.9 billion or 0.4 percent to \$1,174.2 billion. This was at the highest level since the series was first published on a NAICS basis in 1992 and followed a 0.4 percent September increase. The unfilled orders-to-shipments ratio was 6.73, up from 6.71 in September.

Inventories, up twenty-three of the last twenty-four months, increased \$0.5 billion or 0.1 percent to \$655.6 billion. This was also at the highest level since the series was first published on a NAICS basis and followed a 0.2 percent September increase. The inventories-to-shipments ratio was 1.31, up from 1.30 in September.

New Orders

New orders for manufactured durable goods in October, up following two consecutive monthly decreases, increased \$0.6 billion or 0.3 percent to \$243.8 billion, revised from the previously published 0.4 percent increase. This followed a 0.7 percent September decrease.

Transportation equipment, also up following two consecutive monthly decreases, drove the increase, \$2.5 billion or 3.4 percent to \$76.5 billion.

New orders for manufactured nondurable goods decreased \$3.9 billion or 1.5 percent to \$252.7 billion.

Shipments

Shipments of manufactured durable goods in October, up four of the last five months, increased \$0.1 billion or 0.1 percent to \$246.5 billion, unchanged from the previously published increase. This followed a 0.3 percent September increase.

Transportation equipment, also up four of the last five months, drove the increase, \$0.6 billion or 0.8 percent to \$73.1 billion.

Shipments of manufactured nondurable goods, down five of the last six months, decreased \$3.9 billion or 1.5 percent to \$252.7 billion. This followed a 0.2 percent September decrease. Petroleum and coal products, down four consecutive months, drove the decrease, \$4.3 billion or 6.3 percent to \$64.0 billion.

Unfilled Orders

Unfilled orders for manufactured durable goods in October, up eighteen of the last nineteen months, increased \$4.9 billion or 0.4 percent to \$1,174.2 billion, unchanged from the previously published increase. This was at the highest level since the series was first published on a NAICS basis and followed a 0.4 percent September increase.

Transportation equipment, up thirteen of the last fourteen months, led the increase, \$3.4 billion or 0.5 percent to \$746.5 billion.

Inventories

Inventories of manufactured durable goods in October, up eighteen of the last nineteen months, increased \$1.8 billion or 0.5 percent to \$406.6 billion, unchanged from the previously published increase. This was at the highest level since the series was first published on a NAICS basis and followed a 0.5 percent September increase.

Transportation equipment, also up eighteen of the last nineteen months, led the increase, \$0.9 billion or 0.7 percent to \$131.7 billion.

Inventories of manufactured nondurable goods, down five consecutive months, decreased \$1.3 billion or 0.5 percent to \$249.0 billion. This followed a 0.2 percent September decrease. Petroleum and coal products, also down five consecutive months, drove the decrease, \$1.5 billion or 3.3 percent to \$44.8 billion.

By stage of fabrication, October materials and supplies increased 0.4 percent in durable goods and 0.3 percent in nondurable goods. Work in process increased 0.8 percent in durable goods and decreased 3.1 percent in nondurable goods. Finished goods decreased slightly in durable goods and slightly in nondurable goods.

Figures in text are adjusted for seasonality, but not for inflation. Figures on new and unfilled orders exclude data for semiconductor manufacturing. Survey Description

This report is compiled from results of the U.S. Census Bureau's Manufacturers' Shipments, Inventories, and Orders (M3) survey. This survey provides statistics on manufacturers' value of shipments, new orders (net of cancellations), end-of-month order backlog (unfilled orders), end-of-month total inventory (at current cost or market value), and inventories by stage of fabrication (materials and supplies, work-in-process, and finished goods). The M3 includes approximately 4,300 reporting units. Units may be divisions of diversified large companies, large homogenous companies, or single-unit manufacturers in 89 industry categories. Due to the small monthly sample, these 89 categories have been combined into 65 publication levels. The survey methodology assumes that the month-to-month changes of the total operations of those companies in the monthly survey effectively represent the month-to-month movements of all establishments that make up the category. The current coverage levels in the survey show that reported data in the monthly survey represent approximately 60 percent of the shipments estimates at the total manufacturing level. Data published represent manufacturing in a calendar month. The data collection is based on a voluntary survey authorized by Title 13 of the United States Code.

The data presented in this release are based on data obtained from a panel of 4,300 reporting units and provide an indication of the activity within the manufacturing sector. The results differ from what would be obtained from a complete enumeration of all manufacturing companies. In addition, a different panel of 4,300 companies would yield different results. The M3 panel is comprised of companies with \$500 million or more in shipments and a limited number of smaller companies. From a statistical perspective, the panel is not a probability sample; therefore, the sampling errors that are normally provided with sample surveys cannot be measured. Nonsampling errors are attributable to many sources. The use of company or divisional reports to estimate the monthly change for establishments is one source of nonsampling error. The use of primarily large companies to represent the month-to-month movement of all companies is another potential source. Any corrections will be published in the full report. Corrections received after the full report will be released in the next month's advance report. Any revisions made later than two months will be reflected in the annual benchmark publication.
