## Full Report on Manufacturers' Shipments, Inventories and Orders September 2016

#### Summary

New orders for manufactured goods in September, up three consecutive months, increased \$1.4 billion or 0.3 percent to \$455.5 billion, the U.S. Census Bureau reported today. This followed a 0.4 percent August increase.

Shipments, up six of the last seven months, increased \$3.9 billion or 0.8 percent to \$463.0 billion. This followed a 0.2 percent August increase.

Unfilled orders, down four consecutive months, decreased \$4.3 billion or 0.4 percent to \$1,118.8 billion. This followed a 0.2 percent August decrease. The unfilled orders-to-shipments ratio was 6.69, down from 6.79 in August.

Inventories, down following two consecutive monthly increases, decreased \$0.2 billion or virtually unchanged to \$621.4 billion. This followed a 0.1 percent August increase. The inventories-to-shipments ratio was 1.34, down from 1.35 in August.

#### **New Orders**

New orders for manufactured durable goods in September, down following two consecutive monthly increases, decreased \$0.7 billion or 0.3 percent to \$226.8 billion, down from the previously published 0.1 percent decrease. This followed a 0.2 percent August increase.

Transportation equipment, also down following two consecutive monthly increases, drove the decrease, \$0.9 billion or 1.1 percent to \$77.2 billion.

New orders for manufactured nondurable goods increased \$2.1 billion or 0.9 percent to \$228.7 billion.

#### Shipments

Shipments of manufactured durable goods in September, up three of the last four months, increased \$1.8 billion or 0.8 percent to \$234.3 billion, virtually unchanged from the previously published increase. This followed a virtually unchanged August decrease.

Transportation equipment, up following two consecutive monthly decreases, led the increase, \$1.7 billion or 2.2 percent to \$82.0 billion.

Shipments of manufactured nondurable goods, up six of the last seven months, increased \$2.1 billion or 0.9 percent to \$228.7 billion. This followed a 0.5 percent August increase. Petroleum and coal products, up six of the last seven months, led the increase, \$1.5 billion or 4.3 percent to \$37.1 billion.

## **Unfilled Orders**

Unfilled orders for manufactured durable goods in September, down four consecutive months, decreased \$4.3 billion or 0.4 percent to \$1,118.8 billion, virtually unchanged from the previously published decrease. This followed a 0.2 percent August decrease.

Transportation equipment, also down four consecutive months, drove the decrease, \$4.7 billion or 0.6 percent to \$764.1 billion.

### Inventories

Inventories of manufactured durable goods in September, up three consecutive months, increased \$0.3 billion or 0.1 percent to \$383.8 billion, virtually unchanged from the previously published increase. This followed a 0.1 percent August increase.

Machinery, up three of the last four months, led the increase, \$0.3 billion or 0.4 percent to \$65.9 billion.

Inventories of manufactured nondurable goods, down two of the last three months, decreased \$0.5 billion or 0.2 percent to \$237.6 billion. This followed a 0.1 percent August increase. Petroleum and coal products, also down two of the last three months, drove the decrease, \$0.6 billion or 2.2 percent to \$24.6 billion.

By stage of fabrication, September materials and supplies were virtually unchanged in durable goods and decreased 0.1 percent in nondurable goods. Work in process increased 0.2 percent in durable goods and decreased 0.2 percent in nondurable goods. Finished goods were virtually unchanged in durable goods and decreased 0.3 percent in nondurable goods.

The survey methodology assumes that the month-to-month changes of the total operations of the reporting units in the M3 panel effectively represent the month-to-month movements of all establishments that make up the category.

The companies for which shipments data are currently reported or imputed in the M3 survey represent approximately 61 percent of the total value of shipments for manufacturing establishments in the 2012 Economic Census, and these companies include almost two-thirds of the manufacturing companies with \$500 million or more in shipments in the 2012 Economic Census. The companies for which shipments data are currently reported in the M3 survey represent approximately 54 percent of the total value of shipments for manufacturing establishments in the 2012 Economic Census. Statistics based on the M3 panel differ from the results that would be obtained from a complete enumeration of all manufacturing companies. The M3 panel is not based on a probability sample; therefore, the sampling errors that are normally provided with sample surveys cannot be measured. Nonsampling errors are attributable to many sources. The use of company or divisional reports to estimate the monthly change for establishments is one source of nonsampling error. The use of primarily large companies to represent the month-to-month movement of all companies is another potential source. Any corrections will be published in the full report. Corrections received after the full report will be released in the next month's advance report. Any revisions made later than two months will be reflected in the annual benchmark publication.
